Utilizing the 2016 Census Population (updated as of April, 2017), the estimated number of eligible voters in Prince Albert is 26,648. Therefore, the overall voter turnout based on the Mayoral race was 27%. Given the challenges of 2020, it is not surprising that voter turnout is lower than usual. However, in reviewing the results of the past three general elections, the number of voters is only slightly lower than the overall average of the results noted below:
