**TITLE:** Sanitary Lateral Relining Tender

**INCAMERA:**

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. To award the lateral sanitary relining tender #01/21 to Superior Infrastructure for an estimated \$6,800 per service.
2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the Agreement and any other necessary documents.
3. That Tender #01/21 be reviewed at the end of 2021, and possibly be extended for one year at a time for a maximum of three years.

**TOPIC & PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this report is to award the relining of sanitary lateral connections to Superior Infrastructure from Tender #01/21 Lateral Sewer Re-Lining, with possible extensions for up to three additional years.

**BACKGROUND:**

In the summer of 2020 Council increased the formula previously used to encourage residents to replace their sanitary sewer connections through re-lining. This action increased the involvement considerably in an effort to do more for the rate-payer. Due to the increased interest a tender was completed to ensure that we are achieving the best price for work completed.

**PROPOSED APPROACH AND RATIONALE:**

The scope of work was summarized and posted on Sask Tenders to allow all interested contractors that specialize in sanitary lateral relining to review and provide the City of Prince Albert with the costs associated to complete the rehabilitation.

**CONSULTATIONS:**

Attendance to previous No-Dig Shows has brought the process of relining without excavation into the Public Works Department in an attempt to increase the quantity of work completed with limited funds. Extensive conversations and trials in a variety of scenarios has proven that this technology has a relevant presence in the preservation of our sanitary sewer system. As interactions with residents occur, typically due to sewer backups, the sewer re-lining process can be considered as a permanent solution and alternative to excavation.

**COMMUNICATION AND/OR ANNOUNCEMENT PLAN:**

A summary of the proposed work was posted on Sask Tenders for providers of the process to review and submit a bid.

Upon the awarding of the Tender, the Department will forward the agreement to the Clerk's office to be signed and sealed.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:**

The 2021 budget allows for \$135,000 worth of shared relining of sanitary connections at a 80/20 cost sharing with the City taking on the larger share. The City portion at approximately \$5600/ service connection this will allow the completion of 24 services in 2021.
